Ruth Van Reken and **Dr. George Weiblen** will lead multiple sessions and discussions:

Ruth will share more of her wisdom and research about growing up in a third culture such as PNG. A session will focus on attachment issues and related trauma that third culture kids often experience and carry with them into adulthood. Discussion will focus on ways to cope. Individuals and small groups can meet with Ruth throughout the reunion.

George is a University of Minnesota professor and is Science Director and Curator of Plants at the U's Bell Museum. His specialty is the interaction of flowering plants with insect pollinators and pests. George will update us on his ongoing research in PNG, plus share PNG collections, and discuss safe travel options with those interested in visiting PNG. We are excited that his PNG national colleagues at the New Guinea Binatang Research Center in Madang will join us via Zoom for a session. 
