Please send in your pictures as JPEGs by September 27th 2024 to allow ample time for assembling the slide show!

In the Zoom meeting, we will watch the slide show together, then divide out into small groups to discuss what we've seen, focusing on what emotions were elicited. Following that time, we will watch the slideshow again and then divide out into different groupings. This time, we will discuss our favorite scenes. It is hoped that interesting conversations and sharing can happen this way.

Because there might be duplicates of various scenes, every slide you send may not be shown. For example, a number of aerial slides of KLS, or of mission planes or ships, may be received. Only one or two would be selected for the first slide show. Those pictures not shown during the Zoom meeting may then be shown in a second group at the end of the two hours.

Here are some suggestions of quintessential PNG scenes to look for in your photographic collections:

- **a highlands highway with narrow corners**
- **a coastal bridge wiped out, or a road in flood**
- **a mission ship**
- **airplanes landing or taking off**
- **KLS from the air**

- **swimming in ponds, rivers or the ocean**
- **fruits**
- **markets**

Our next PNG/KLS/SPLC Reunion will be held:

Thursday October 2 to Sunday October 5, 2025

It will be held again at Mt Olivet Conference Center in Farmington, Minnesota.

Welcoming, interesting, informative sessions will be part of the Reunion!

Two highlights are:

- A hilarious hour-and-a-half will erupt Saturday afternoon, instigated by the ***“Looney Lutherans”***, a troop of three comediettes, led by Greta Grosch. They poke a lot of good-natured fun about growing up Lutheran. Over the last two decades they have performed on stage, in church basements, in large and small venues, sharing their interactive musical humor. *Audience members everywhere love their comical, musical shows, even those who are not Lutheran! Can you believe that!*” Greta has a special connection with our group in that she spent some of her youth in Lae where she attended Lae International High School. Her mother taught at Balob and MLS and her father was with Kristen Radio.
- Another opportunity at this Reunion will be a time for *meditative, in-depth, respectful conversation*. Called ***“MK Nexus”***, it will be a time to share memorable experiences we had as MK children, and the impact they might have had on us, leading us as individuals to become who we are today.

TREASURED DIAMONDS AWAITING DISCOVERY

- The ***first “diamond”*** is a scholar by the name of **Jared Diamond**, a professor at UCLA, a prolific book and article writer, and an astute, insightful observer of humanity. At just 26 years of age, he got involved in studying and cataloguing birds in New Guinea, both PNG and West Irian. He totally immersed himself in the various regions he was studying, and frequently was the only European in the midst of those New Guinean villages, thus gaining astounding insights, personally and culturally. He has commented, “Once you’ve been to New Guinea, the rest of the world is boring.”

- a. Prof Diamond may join us as a participant on Zoom for the “Quintessential Photographic Memories,” October 4, 2024, and will be with us for the 2025 PNG Reunion at Mt Olivet, October 2—5, and possibly for a Zoom Meeting in the Spring of 2025, still being planned.
- b. Diamond’s writings to explore:
 - i. His Pulitzer Prize winning “Guns, Germs, and Steel” (1997), in which he credits Yali, the son of the infamous “cargo cult” leader Yali, for insightful questions which led to him exploring the development of human civilizations and cultures;
 - ii. “Collapse, How Societies Choose to Fail or Succeed” (2005, 2011);
 - iii. “The World Until Yesterday” (2012);
 - iv. “Upheaval” (2019).

These last two show his amazingly wide knowledge and PNG experiences.
- c. Or, view his 3 *Interviews with an Author* on YouTube.

- o He has pointed out that MK’s are “profoundly stamped by where they were born,” to which Cynthia breathed a sigh of relief, “We have another human soul who understands us!”
- o The **second “diamond”** to look forward to is a compatriot who was adopted into the Goldhardt family, **Barbara Carlyon**. She is scheduled to join us by Zoom from Australia on Friday evening, October 3, during the 2025 PNG Reunion. She has incredible insights on growing up in a missionary family, and you can learn more about her through the book “Mama Kuma” written by her daughter, Deborah.

Uplifting worship experiences, outstanding meals, enjoying the outdoors, as well as quality conversations with one another will again be a part of the 2025 PNG/KLS/SPLC Reunion.

We note that this Reunion coincides with the 50th Anniversary of PNG Independence!
